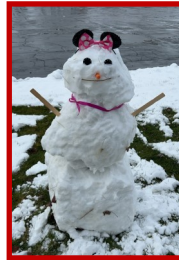

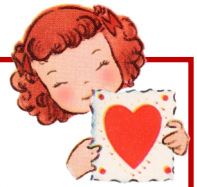

Resident of the Month: Marie Burl

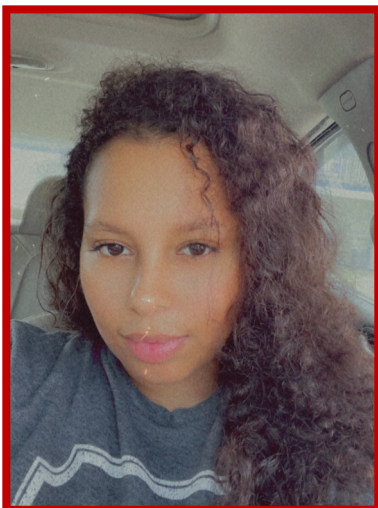
The only girl in a houseful of boys, Marie is the brains behind the outfit. She lives a simple life and always does more for others before herself.
