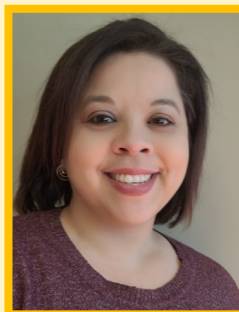


Congratulations to Edith and Bill Kettler, our 2024 Chesaning Union Court homecoming queen and king!

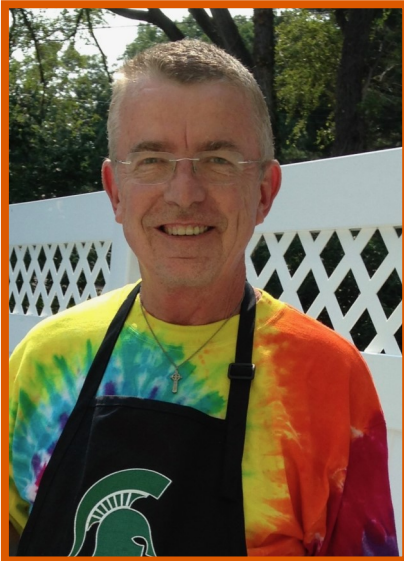
